### Special Birthday Edition

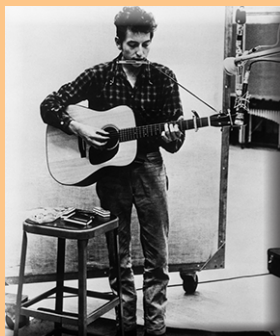
