Kim Weston was a rising solo artist at Motown and also paired with Marvin Gaye in 1967.



Gladys Knight & the Pips are pop, rock and soul royalty. Consistent hit makers and live concert crowd-pleasers for decades.



In 1972 Motown left Detroit for sunnier skies in Los Angeles. The music and the business changed. The family had been replaced by a corporation, and it showed.
