Looking back at 60 years of musicals that opened during the summer before Labor Day, only about a dozen became bonafide hits running a year or more. From 1969 – 2019 the first summer opening that was a hit was in 1975, *Chicago*. Coincidentally, *A Chorus Line* also opened that same summer.

At one time nothing opened on the summer. Broadway was on its unofficial “holiday” with little new getting produced during June, July and August.

On this edition of Broadway Bound we look at 11 summer openers that were hits, that’s it.

During the summer many shows close. After the Tony Awards, if a new show didn’t get a lot of attention, producers pull the plug. The summer of 2019 is seeing five new shows close.

Finally we look to the new season and anticipate *Moulin Rouge* and *Tina: The Tina Turner Musical*.
